* Adjective:- an adjective describes / modifies noun or pronoun

② An adjective is a word that add more information ^{noun} or pronoun about.

Types of adjective.

① adjective of quality :- The words which show the quality of a person or thing.

ex:- ① He is an honest man.

② mumbai is a large city.

③ she is a beautiful girl.

① Adjective of quantity :-
quality word

① size :- large, big, small, huge

② shape :- round, street, circle

③ colour :- red, green, black

④ quality of person :- kind, honest, good, dirty

② Adjective of quantity :- An adjective which shows the quantity is called adjective of quantity.

quantity word :- Any, some, little, enough, all, few etc.

* These words (Adjectives) are used with uncountable nouns.

ex :- ① He did not drink any milk.

② I have enough sugar.

③ I eat some rice.

* How many (countable noun)

③ proper adjective :- proper adjectives are the adjectives which is are form of proper noun.

④ demonstrative Adjective :- A demonstrative adjective directly refers to something or someone

demonstrative adjective :- This, That, These, Those

(This, That, These, Those) = (verb)
pronoun

(This, That, These, Those) = (noun)

③ That is a big house.

④ These are wild animals.

⑤ These shirts are good.

⑤ possessive adjective :- A possessive adjective indicates possession or ownership

possessive adjective :- my, our, your, His, her, their

ex :- ① My car is parked outside

② His cat is very cute

③ our job is almost done

④ Her book are interesting

⑥ Interrogative adjective :- An interrogative adjective is used to ask questions. And interrogative adjective must be followed by a noun or pronoun.

Interrogative adjective :- whose, which, what

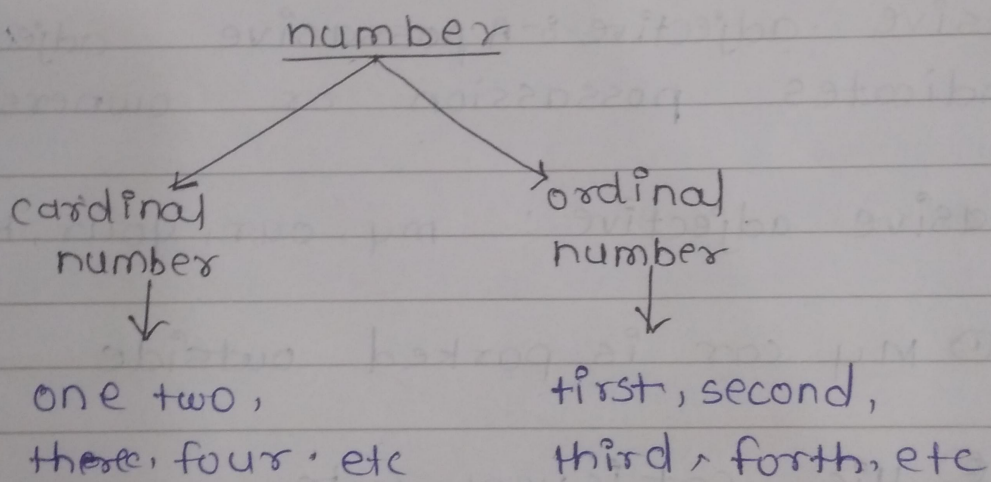
* (Wh word + noun + ?)
